

Face Mask for children at MCV/VUC

Please all instructions before beginning

Fabric needed: (fabric children would like) 1 piece 8" x 14" inches
2 strips 1 3/4" x 6" inches

Elastic: 2 pieces 1/4" by 6 1/2" inches or round cord 1/16" x 6 1/2"



Step one: with right sides together, fold and stitch (1/4" seam) along the 8" edge, turn right side out, press flat. Place the piece with the seam to the bottom. Draw a line (use a disappearing marker, these lines will be seen when mask is finished) 1 1/2" from the bottom edge. Make another line 1" above this line or 2 1/2" from the bottom seam edge.

Fold the seam edge to the line and make a crease, you should have 1 1/2" edge here. Flip, pin on each end. Step two: pleat 1/2" from the top of the pleat. Step three: mark line 3" from seam edge, pin on each end and stitch 1/8" stitch along each end to hold pleats in place.
